

The Victim Services Coordinator provides victims with notification as specified in the Texas Government Code Annotated, Section §76.016 which include:

- The fact that the defendant has been placed on community supervision;
- The conditions of community supervision imposed on the defendant by the court; and
- The date, time, and location of any hearing or proceeding at which the conditions of the defendant's placement on community supervision may be revoked or terminated.

Victims are also provided with information that is public record as follows:

- Court ordered community supervision identifying the department and jurisdiction;
- A written copy of the conditions of supervision;
- The name of the supervising officer;
- Victim service coordinator contact information;
- Motion to revoke supervision being filed and the results of the motion;
- Information regarding the transfer of offender to another jurisdiction and contact information;
- and
- Information that the offender has been placed in residential confinement and release from confinement.

The Coordinator also keeps victims informed regarding restitution payments and additional sanctions for non-compliance on the part of the defendant or defendants related to their case.
